TO THE OUTER LEFT SIDE TOP AND BOTTOM ARE TWO CARVED SHIELDS, EACH WITH CARVED MERCHANT MARK SYMBOLS OF A 4 AND A CROSS, WITH A DOUBLE XX BELOW. FOR SIMILAR MERCHANT MARKS SEE ENGLISH MERCHANT MARKS, F.A.GIRLING. SURROUNDING THE PORTRAIT PANEL IS PIERCED GOTHIC TRACERY. THIS CARVED TUDOR DOOR HAS A REAL PRESENCE.
