AN EXTREMELY RARE LATE 14TH CENTURY ENGLISH OAK SCULPTURE. CIRCA 1380.

SELDOM DO MEDIEVAL ENGLISH CARVED SCULPTURES COME ONTO THE OPEN MARKET AND WHEN THEY DO THEY ARE NORMALLY ECCLESIASTICAL SAINTS. SO FOR AN OAK SCULPTURE OF THIS NATURE IT IS AN EXCEEDINGLY RARE DISCOVERY, THIS SCULPTURE OF A LATE 14TH CENTURY KNIGHT IN SWORD COMBAT DRESS IS SO PLEASING ON THE EYE, HIS FACE HAS A SERENE SOFTNESS WHERE PEOPLE OVER THE CENTURIES HAVE TOUCHED HIS FACE. LARGE AMOUNTS OF THE ORIGINAL POLYCHROME REMAIN. HE IS CARVED COMPLETELY IN THE ROUND, THE STAND IS PART OF THE CARVING ITSELF, ONLY THE HILT OF HIS SWORD REMAINS AND WE BELIEVE HE HAS ALWAYS



BEEN A THREE QUARTER LENGTH CARVING. FROM THE STYLE OF HIS DRESS HE HAS BEEN DATED TO THE LATE 14TH CENTURY AND WITHOUT DOUBT ENGLISH.
