THIS BEAUTIFUL CHAIR WAS DISCOVERED OVER THIRTY YEARS AGO IN A FARM HOUSE ON THE SHROPSHIRE/WELSH BORDERS AND HAS BEEN KEPT IN THE SAME COLLECTION EVER SINCE THEN.

IT HAS A VERY SCULPTURAL PRESENSE, HEWN FROM THE TRUNK OF AN ASH TREE, THE SEAT WAS GENERALLY MADE FROM A SEPERATE PLANK OR PLANKS AND INSERTED INTO THE TRUNK. THE RICH PATINATED ASH PEEPS THROUGH ON THE MORE HANDLED AREAS OF THE CHAIR.
