A WONDERFULLY POWERFUL HENRY VIII OAK AND IRONBOUND STRONG CHEST. ENGLISH. CIRCA 1520.

THIS GREAT TUDOR PERIOD CHEST HAS BEEN CONSTRUCTED FROM THICK HEWN OAK PLANKS ALMOST 3" THICK, THEN BOUND IN IRON STRAPS WITH HEAVY IRON HINGES AND HASP.

ORIGINALLY PLAIN TO THE FRONT, IT HAS PROBABLY CHANGED OWNERSHIP IN THE EARLY 17TH CENTURY OR WAS GIVEN AS A MARRIAGE GIFT TO G.W AND C.W IN THE YEAR 1630.
