ST GEORGE HAS BEEN THE PATRON SAINT OF ENGLAND SINCE 1222 AND OF SEVERAL OTHER EUROPEAN CITIES INCLUDING VENICE, HIS MOST FAMOUS ACT WAS SAVING THE DAMSEL IN DISTRESS BY SLAYING THE DRAGON, SYMBOLISING THE TRIUMPH OF GOOD AND EVIL.
